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

Background & Context:

Hotel 166



Outcomes:

- **60%** exited to permanent housing or residential treatment programs
- **28%** of people living with a mental health condition were newly initiated on psychiatric medications
- 62% reported that their mental health improved or stabilized during their stay in the program

***** Program Overview: The Haven on Lincoln

The Haven on Lincoln **combines healthcare and social services to reflect a "housing first" approach** that works to interrupt the pattern of people living with complex physical and behavioral conditions cycling through systems.

Goal:

Provide transitional housing and wraparound healthcare and social services to people experiencing homelessness who are also living with untreated physical and behavioral health conditions, thereby **improving overall health and housing outcomes for residents.**

Desired outcomes:

- 1. Participants exiting into permanent housing
- 2. Participants engaged in primary care and behavioral healthcare services that address underlying health conditions
- 3. Reduction in healthcare and emergency services spending

Program Operator: VOA Illinois

CDPH has selected **VOA Illinois as the City's partner** to deliver a fully staffed medical, mental health, and social services team of providers to appropriately meet patient needs as well as manage The Haven on Lincoln.

Hope Hall

Melrose Park, Illinois



Created in collaboration with the Hines VA Medical Center, Hope Hall is based on the "safe haven" residential model for reaching the most at-risk and chronically homeless veterans.

- Safe housing and intensive services for up to 14 male or female veterans who are facing homelessness and struggling with serious mental illness, substance use disorder, or both
- Programs that prepare these veterans for greater stability and independence in more permanent settings like group homes or supportive housing

Key Outcomes:

- 81% of Veterans going on to permanent housing
- 30% decrease in substance use disorder- and mental illnessrelated incident reports to VA





Hope Manor I

West Humboldt Park, Chicago

Hope Manor I provides:

- Immediate housing for up to 50 veterans in need of intensive services at the point of referral
- Affordable housing with rental support for up to 30 veterans who require less intensive services but longer-term rental assistance

Hope Manor II

Englewood, Chicago

One of the first large scale, supportive housing developments in the country specifically designed for veterans with families:

- A campus-style development for 73 veterans with families, including studio 3BR apartments and 4BR townhomes
- A healthy and vibrant community with immediate access to our services to support the quality of life for veterans and their families

***** The Haven on Lincoln Program Structure




Supportive Housing

- Every resident will be assessed for program eligibility ahead of intake
- Duration of stays: 3-6 months
- Single or dual occupancy based on assessment
- Max Occupancy: Up to 40 residents at one time

On-Site Staffing

Program Management

Case workers Recovery specialists Clinical therapists Health care providers



Wrap-Around Services

- Transportation support
- Active case management
- Individual and group therapy opportunities
- Primary and behavioral health care

***** Property Management and Safety

24/7 On-Site Security Staffing

- Daytime: intensive program staff engagement and ongoing security presence
- Overnight: regular rounds and ongoing security presence
- All staff receive trauma-informed and de-escalation type training to work with this population.
- Security staff serve as a support to program staff as needed

Full Site Security Camera Monitoring System

- 24/7 real-time monitoring of the site, including external perimeter, all entryways, top and bottom of all stairwells. Monitored by security staff.
- Interior views are limited to entryways and hallways. Not in offices, bedrooms. Camera positioning to see every doorway.

Site Perimeter and Enclosure

- Entire open perimeter will be fenced to limit ingress to a single gated entry with key card access.
- South parking lot will be redeveloped as a green space for residents.
- Gated north parking lot with parking with 12 on-site staff parking spots

External Partnerships

Regular coordination with CPD and the 20th District to ensure coordination of safety and security
 Ongoing partnership with other key healthcare and community partners including the 40th Ward Office 2/9/2024



★ Benefits of Proposed New Site Use

Current State of Site as a Motel

- Fully unknown population
- Transient stays by design
- Limited video surveillance
- No on-site security
- No full-time professional staff

- No security fencing
- No secured entries to parking lot or building
- No control over visitors
- No accountable owners/partners/operators



Proposed State of Site as The Haven on Lincoln

- Fully vetted, assessed, and unknown population
- 3 6 month stays until placement into permanent housing
- Robust video security and surveillance system
- Fully secured site 24/7
- Fully staffed site with professional and management staff

- Fully fence and landscaped site to secure perimeter
- Single secured entryway to site with locking gate
- Robust and controlled visitor
 policy
- All partners are accountable to City and community

- 46 existing rooms



X Design Partner: Gensler

DOH has selected **Gensler as the City's design partner** to support the architectural planning and redesign of the property from a trauma-informed lens for use as The Haven on Lincoln.

- The site is in the Lincoln Avenue Commercial Corridor, which is subject to <u>neighborhood design</u> <u>guidelines</u> established by the Department of Planning and Development (DPD)
- The property will be updated as needed to effectively implement the program while staying in line with the design plans for the corridor



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
