


This ordinance establishes regular reporting to Alders and the public by the Dept of Family and Support Services (DFSS) on shelter exits of New Arrivals in partnership with:

- Department of Technology & Innovation (DTI)
- The Office of Immigrant, Migrant and Refugee Rights (OMIRR)
- Committee on Immigrant and Refugee Rights (CIRR).

The data that we are requesting already exists, we believe a formalized reporting of such data will be helpful to alders who have New Arrival shelters in their wards to understand the impact of exits in their communities.

## <u>Temporary Shelter Exits Due to 60-Day Policy</u>

A total of **24** individuals have exited the shelter system to date due to the 60-day shelter policy. **2** individuals exited on **March 24**.

Upon exiting, the city does not require the individuals to share their plans or next steps. Those exiting have the option to return to the Landing Zone and be reprocessed and placed in shelter once again if appropriate beds are available or opt for onward movement.

Extensions to the policy will be determined on an individual basis. Factors from the Department of Family and Support Services' (DFSS) Limited Stay Extension Policy still apply and have always included public benefit enrollment, pregnancy or infant care, medical care, disability, mental health, gender-based violence concerns, bereavement, medical isolation or quarantine or families with children under 18.



## Resident Grievance Metrics






